GiggleIT is a project designed to help schools teach reading and writing in a fun and meaningful manner. The International Association of School Librarianship (IASL) will host and publish students' work on the GiggleIT web site. Eventually, the GiggleIT teams hopes to publish an International Children's Digidoc (new word for ebook) of children's writing – jokes, short stories, poetry, personal stories. The team would like to include photographs of schools and country scenes in the publication. However, in order to make this a cybersafe project, the following rules apply.

Photographs & pictures/designs

Must not contain images of children where the children can be identified.

Writings, Pictures/designs

Will only contain a child's initials and school name.

The safety of our contributors is paramount at all times. When the final publication has been completed, child authors will be recognised in an alphabetical index only.

When sending in student work for publication on the web site, please follow these simple rules and use this as a teaching moment to discuss cybersafety with your students.
