How will it work?

- Step 3: Send in your student contributions to giggle_it@live.com.au clearly stating the name of the project and your school.
- Step 4: Student images, designs, drawings or paintings will be published first on your school webpages @ <http://www.iasl-online.org/sla/giggleIT/regions.htm>
- Step 5: Competition entries will receive a certificate recognising their work.
- Step 6: Emily will decide on 3 winning entries and 10 runners up.
